WHEREAS, in calculating the amount to be raised by taxation, the Fire District No. 12 has taken into account the assessed valuation of taxable property in the Fire District No. ,

The 2014 proposed budget adequately provides for the fire protection and prevention needs of Colonia. Significant changes include increases of \$50,000 in facilities maintenance in order to replace our HVAC systems, the purchase of a replacement Fire Chief's Command vehicle for \$75,000, and an additional \$45,000 for the replacement of obsolete radios, which are partially offset by a \$25,000 decrease in fire hydrant rentals from the Middlesex Water Company and a reduction of \$125,000 for an ambulance purchased in the 2013 budget.

Complete a brief statement describing the impact the proposed Annual Budget will have on the Amount to be Raised by Taxation to support the district budget and on the Restricted and Unreserved Fund Balance(s). Explain increases or decreases in the tax rate and utilization of fund balances. If unreserved fund balance is reduced by more than 10%, explain the projected impact on the following year's budget.

The Amount to be Raised by Taxation will increase by approximately \$25,000, or 1.59% over the 2013 budget. Restricted fund balance will increase by \$100,000 raised in 2013 under the final installment of an apparatus replacement reserve approved in 2008. The District's Unreserved Fund Balance will increase by approximately \$150,000, to an amount in excess of \$800,000.

The District is complying fully with the Property Tax Levy Cap by carefully monitoring current expenses while maintaining our facilities and apparatus in good working order. We have not needed to use our Levy Cap Bank in any of our budget years.
